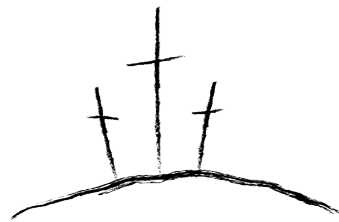
Registration is 5:00-6:00 on Friday with dinner to follow. The retreat ends with worship after breakfast on Sunday.
