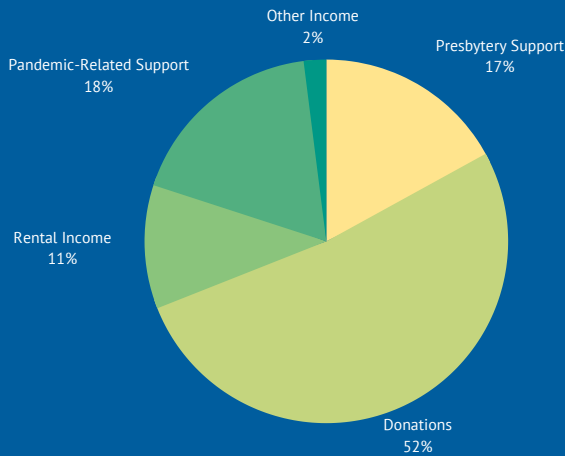

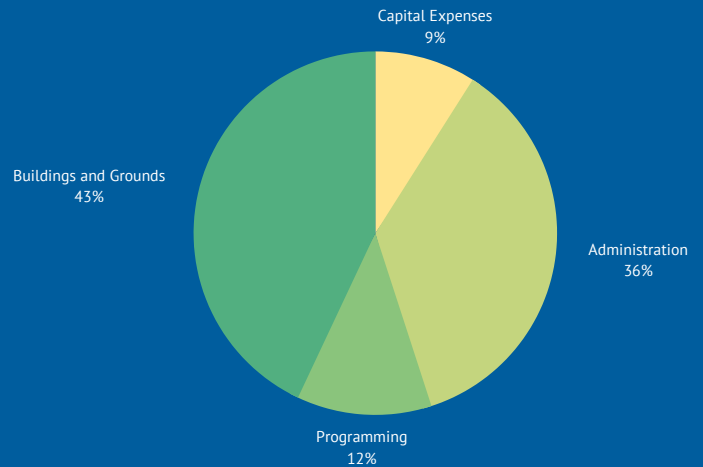
FINANCIAL STATEMENT

In this unusual year, our percentages are substantially different from previous years. Please refer to the second set of charts to view a 3-year average.

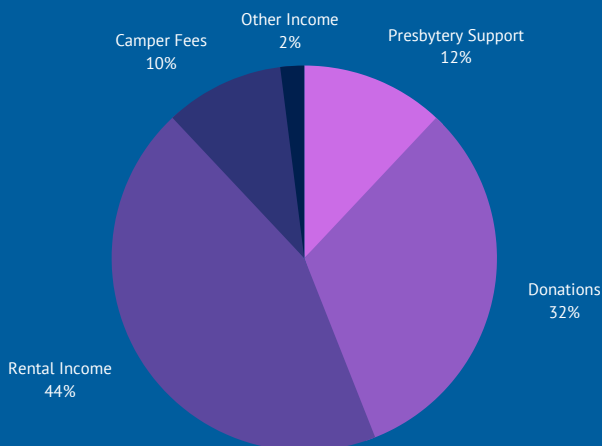
INCOME \$541,264
